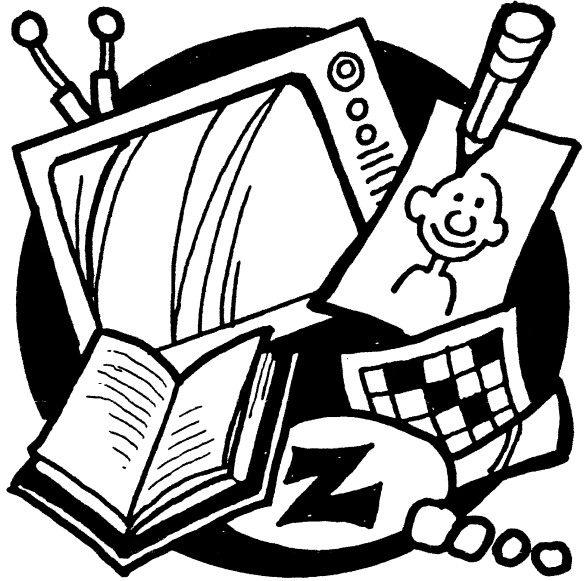


11. WHERE ARE THE KIDS AT 11 P.M.?
